

**ORDINANCE NO. 71-24**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF THE EXPENDITURE TO SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS:** The Service Director has requested to increase Purchase Order #2024-1125 from \$2,000 to \$62,000, which requires the Council’s approval.

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

**SEC. 1:** That the increase to Purchase Order #2024-1125 from \$2,000 to \$62,000 is hereby authorized for the Street Department.

**SEC. 2:** That the funds to cover this expenditure are available in Account No. 102-0145-53321.

**SEC. 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

**SEC. 4:** That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason there are ongoing emergency repairs to the traffic signal system; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
