

**ORDINANCE NO. 111-24****AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE MODIFICATIONS TO THE MEDINA COUNTY THOROUGHFARE PLAN PROPOSED PROJECT LIST AS RECOMMENDED BY THE MEDINA AREA TRANSPORTATION TASK FORCE.**

**WHEREAS:** In 2001, the Medina Area Transportation Task Force comprised of individuals from the four adjacent townships, County government, business and the City was formed by the City to evaluate the possible solutions to the congestion problems in the area; and

**WHEREAS:** The Task Force was charged with making long-term and short-term recommendations dealing with problems associated with traffic flow and safety in the general area of the City; and

**WHEREAS:** The Medina Area Transportation Task Force presented their Final Report in December, 2001 and was adopted by Ord. 107-02, passed June 24, 2002; and

**WHEREAS:** The Medina Area Transportation Task Force reconvened on April 2, 2024 and determined that due to residential development since the implementation of the Medina County Thoroughfare Plan in 2002, modifications of the Plan Project List at the Southern Corridor were in order; and

**WHEREAS:** The Medina Area Transportation Task Force met on May 7, 2024, and by unanimous vote, recommended the following modifications to the Plan Project List at the Southern Corridor:

**Remove:**

Number 32. SR 3/SR 162 Intersections (State)  
2006  
Reconstruction of both intersections to provide left turn lanes to improve site distance for safety

Number 33. Southwest Connector (City/Township & Developer)  
Future  
Show these connections on the City and County Planning maps to better coordinate traffic flow in future

**Add:**

Address needed connections or permanent turnaround of Grovewood Lane in Lafayette Township as part of any development of the subject property

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

- SEC. 1:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the modifications as stated above to the Medina County Thoroughfare Plan Proposed Project List, as recommended by the Medina Area Transportation Task Force.
- SEC. 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 3:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
