

ORDINANCE NO. 163-25

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING TO CREATE AND GOVERN A CYBERSECURITY POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AUDITOR OF THE STATE OF OHIO'S GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS: That the State of Ohio is requiring all municipalities to create and govern a cybersecurity policy to be adopted prior to January 1, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the City of Medina does hereby create and govern a cybersecurity policy that protects the data and network of the City of Medina in accordance with the Auditor of State of Ohio's guidelines.

SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
