## ORDINANCE NO. 72-19

AN ORDINANCE REJECTING ALL DESIGN BUILD PROPOSALS SUBMITTED FOR A PARKING FACILITY ADJACENT TO MEDINA CITY HALL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- WHEREAS: Pursuant to Ordinance No. 52-18, passed March 26, 2018, Council authorized the Mayor to employ a Design-Build Bidding Process for engineering, design and construction of a Parking Facility adjacent to Medina City Hall; and
- WHEREAS: Pursuant to Ordinance No. 52-18, passed March 26, 2018, on March 22, 2019 the City received technical and cost proposals from CPS Construction Group, Inc., the Ruhlin Company, and Mike Coates Construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Council of the City of Medina hereby rejects all Design Build Proposals submitted pursuant to Ordinance No. 52-18, passed March 26, 2018, for a Parking Facility adjacent to Medina City Hall.
- SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for furtherance of the public health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants and visitors to the City in order to provide necessary and safe off-street parking to the public to further the interests of the City of Medina at the earliest possible time; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
