

**ORDINANCE NO. 94-20**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXEMPTION TO SECTIONS 1133.04, 1135.05, 1137.04 AND CHAPTER 1153 OF THE CITY OF MEDINA PLANNING AND ZONING CODE TO PERMIT ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL OF CONDITIONALLY PERMITTED OUTDOOR DINING AREAS FOR EXISTING RESTAURANTS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC STATEWIDE RESTRICTIONS, UNTIL SUCH STATEWIDE RESTRICTIONS ARE LIFTED OR DECEMBER 1, 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

**SEC. 1:** That the temporary exemption to Sections 1133.04, 1135.05, 1137.04 and Chapter 1153 of the City of Medina Planning and Zoning Code to permit administrative approval of conditionally permitted outdoor dining areas for existing restaurants during the Covid-19 pandemic statewide restrictions, until such statewide restrictions are lifted or December 1, 2020, is hereby authorized, and subject to the Law Director’s final approval.

**SEC. 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

**SEC. 3:** That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason reopening approval of restaurants is expected in the coming weeks; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
