

ORDINANCE NO. 157-21

**AN ORDINANCE REJECTING ALL PROPOSALS
SUBMITTED FOR MARKETING AND SOLICITATION
SERVICES FOR THE MEDINA COMMUNITY RECREATION
CENTER.**

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Ordinance No. 94-21, passed June 14, 2021, Council authorized the Mayor to request proposals for Marketing and Solicitation services for the Medina Community Recreation Center (MCRC); and

WHEREAS: Only one proposal was submitted, primarily for naming rights for the exterior of the Recreation Center. The RFP specifically states that naming rights would not be considered at this time and focused on a donation recognition program, pursuant to sponsorship categories defined in the Joint Operating Agreement with Medina City Schools.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MEDINA, OHIO:**

SEC. 1: That the Council of the City of Medina hereby rejects the proposal from Superlative Group submitted in response to Ordinance No. 94-21, passed June 14, 2021, for Marketing and Solicitation services for the Medina Community Recreation Center.

SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
