

ORDINANCE NO. 42-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PAYOUT UNUSED 2021 VACATION TIME TO THREE CITY OF MEDINA EMPLOYEES.

- SEC. 1:** Three City employees ended calendar year 2021 with vacation hours over the maximum carryover amounts, and did not use the minimum 3 weeks of vacation to qualify for a payout as required by the Salaries and Benefits Code, Section 31.13 (2)(A); and
- SEC. 2:** After converting some comp, sick and personal time used to vacation used, these three employees still did not meet the three-week minimum, prompting this request that Council authorize vacation payouts for Nino Piccoli, Barbara Dzur and Kurt Gehring.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1:** That the Finance Director is authorized to payout 72 hours of unused vacation time to Nino Piccoli, 13 hours to Barbara Dzur, and 89 hours to Kurt Gehring.
- SEC. 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 3:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
