

RESOLUTION NO. 169-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES, STATE OF OHIO FOR THE 2024 BODY WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The City of Medina, Ohio intends to apply for a 2024 Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS), State of Ohio Body Worn Camera Grant to replace current body worn cameras that are end of life, for the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to file an application for grant assistance for the 2024 Office of Criminal Justice Services, State of Ohio Body Worn Camera Grant for replacement body worn cameras for the Police Department.

SEC. 2: That if the Grant is awarded the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the Grant and complete all documentation for the implementation and administration of the Grant.

SEC. 3: That this Resolution shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the grant application is due; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
