Acme Fresh Market opened its 17th store, and its first in Medina County, on August 7. Located at 1225 South Court Street, the store has a honeycomb-inspired ceiling design that is a nod to Medina's beekeeping heritage. The new store covers 56,360 square feet and will employ 80 workers. It features local Medina-made products and they have Medina-Themed commemorative bags. The store includes a deli, bakery, meat department, pharmacy, and the signature Acme cow. Kids to age 12 are reminded that the coloring contest entries are due by Friday, August 8, at 5 pm.
