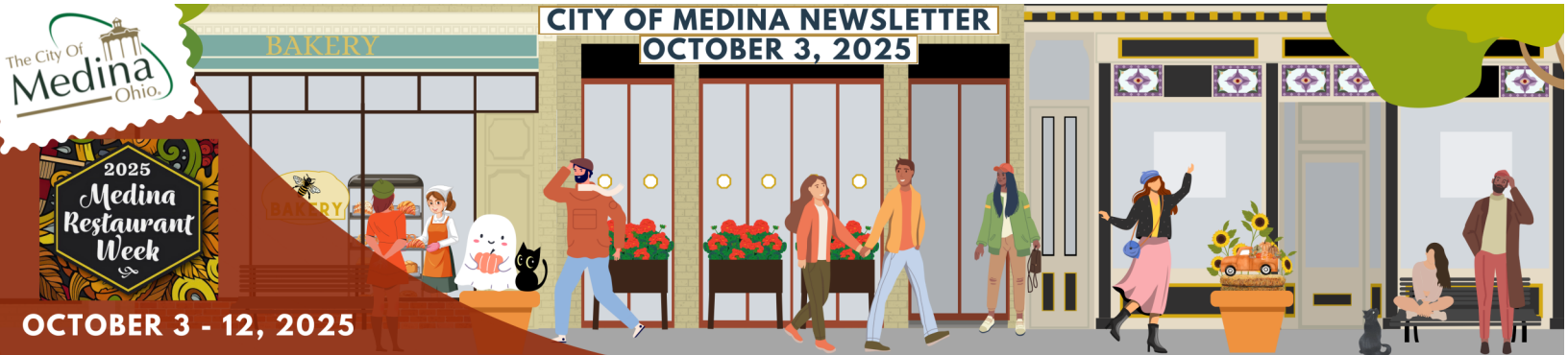




Upcoming Events October

America 250-Medina Heritage Tree Dedication - October 4, 11:30 am



The community, especially children, are invited to join the Medina County Commissioners and City of Medina officials for the dedication of the America 250 Heritage Tree. Each county in Ohio has been gifted a tree from the America 250-Ohio Commission, and the Medina County tree will be planted in the county seat, in Medina's Uptown Park. A program will be held in the Gazebo before moving to the planting site. The Heritage Tree program selected the white oak as the Heritage Tree, as it can grow in many soil types, resists most disease, and is native to Ohio.

2025-2026 Municipal Deer Control Program

The 2025-2026 Municipal Deer Control Program is now in progress. Archery Hunting, by permit, will occur within City Limits from September 27, 2025- February 1, 2026. Hunters may be permitted to hunt on private property and select public properties as long as they meet the application requirements, follow the rules and regulations of the program, and have their elevated platform location inspected prior to use. The Medina Police Department issues the permits for select qualified hunters and after a safety inspection of the location. *Medina City Ordinance 505.11(a)(1)*.
