April Showers Bring Grass and Other Yard Waste Pick-up Begins April 21 - Here Are the Yard Waste Rules

Yard Waste Preparation: Place in plastic or metal containers only; rubbish cans under 40 gallons in size are preferred. Label the container with large, offset colored letters labeled "YARD WASTE". Do not mix yard waste with rubbish. Yard waste in plastic or paper bags will not be collected. Bundle cut branches with string or twine, into 4 foot lengths or less and NO WIDER than 2 feet. The weight of each bundle or container MUST be UNDER 35 LBS.

What Is Yard Waste?: Yard waste is organic waste generated during regular household gardening and landscaping, including: GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, TWIGS, BRANCHES AND SHRUBBERY.

What Is Not Yard Waste?: NO ROCKS, DIRT, SOD, PLASTIC POTS/BAGS, FOOD WASTE or GRAVEL.

Where to Put Your Yard Waste Items: At the curbside. Bundles and containers must be 6 feet away from trash containers, mailboxes, and/or cars.

When To Put Your Yard Waste Out: Weekly, on the day of your regular pick up by 6:00 a.m.

Other Options: Residents may also take bulk items to the Medina Solid Waste District Facility located at 8700 Lake Road, Seville. Phone 330-769-0289 or www.recyclemedinacounty.com for details.
