Summer Kicks Into Full Swing With a Two - Concerts Weekend

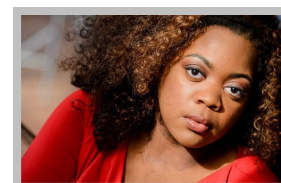
Medina Community Band

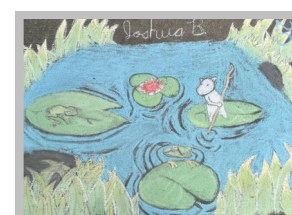


Garden Party and Stroll - Saturday, June 21, 5 pm
