### Water Main Improvement Project to Impact Traffic and Parking

During the week of July 28<sup>th</sup>, the contractor will be completing water main tieins within the intersections of West Liberty Street and North Elmwood Avenue and West Liberty Street and South Court Street. The contractor will begin working on transferring water service lines on South Elmwood Avenue between West Smith Road and Lafayette Road.

Businesses or residents that will have their water service transferred can expect to be without water service for approximately two (2) to four (4) hours while this work is completed. Businesses or residents will be notified prior to having their water transferred.

West Liberty Street will continue to be maintained in the westbound direction utilizing the south lane while work is occurring in the north lane. South Elmwood Avenue between West Liberty Street and West Washington Street will be back open as normal for the week of July 28<sup>th</sup>. Two way traffic on South Elmwood Avenue between West Smith Road and Lafayette Road will be maintained with flaggers.
