### Water Main Improvement Project to Impact Traffic and Parking

For the week of August 18, the contractor will be continuing with the pavement restoration on West Liberty Street, South Elmwood Avenue and West Washington Street.

The contractor may also be working on the concrete sidewalk and curb restoration along West Liberty Street and South Elmwood Avenue. Traffic on West Liberty Street will continue to be maintained in the westbound direction utilizing the south lane while work is occurring in the north lane. Once the pavement restoration is complete, West Liberty Street will then be re-opened. Traffic along South Elmwood Avenue between West Liberty Street and West Washington Street will be maintained utilizing the west lane while pavement restoration work is occurring in the east lane. Once pavement restoration work is complete, South Elmwood Avenue will be re-opened. West Washington Street between South Elmwood Avenue and South Vine Street will remain closed to through traffic while pavement restoration work is occurring. Schedule is weather dependent.
