Water Main Improvement Project to Impact Traffic and Parking

On Friday, August 22, the contractor will be working on pavement restoration within the intersection of West Washington Street and South Elmwood Avenue. Traffic will be maintained with flaggers; however, delays should be expected.

The week of August 25, the contractor will be continuing with the pavement restoration on West Washington Street between South Elmwood Avenue and South Vine Street. West Liberty Street and South Elmwood Avenue traffic will be reopened fully assuming all work within the intersection of South Elmwood Avenue and West Washington Street is completed on August 22. West Washington Street between South Elmwood Avenue and South Vine Street will be closed to through traffic while pavement restoration work continues. North/South traffic along South Huntington Street through the intersection of West Washington Street will be maintained at all times, except when pavement restoration is occurring directly within the intersection.
