Fast Charging EV Location Now Available in City Hall Parking Deck

FLO, a fast-charging EV station, is now available on the first floor of the parking deck behind Medina City Hall. The parking deck can be accessed via West Liberty Street or North Elmwood Avenue. Look for the FLO logo on the ground level south wall in the parking deck. The city also has traditional charging stations in the southwest corner of the ground floor of the parking deck The parking deck is open 24/7.



Water Main Improvement Project to Impact Traffic and Parking

The week of September 15th, the contractor will begin the asphalt resurfacing work along West Liberty Street between North Court Street and South Elmwood Avenue; along South Elmwood Avenue between West Liberty Street and West Washington Street; and along West Washington Street between South Elmwood Avenue and South Vine Street. This work will include the milling off and replacement of the surface course of asphalt pavement in certain sections along these roadways. While work is occurring, delays should be expected. South Elmwood Avenue, between West Smith Road and Lafayette Road will be reopened fully to traffic.
