The Hope and Healing Survivor Resource Center is seeking a full time Crisis Intervention Specialist to join their team at the Medina Shelter. This position maintains a safe, supportive environment for survivors residing in the shelter. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:



- Provide confidential, trauma-informed support to survivors, including but not limited to: crisis intervention, advocacy, hotline responses, shelter intakes, referrals, safety planning, and follow-up care.
