## **Summary and Assumptions**

The City of Medina Finance Department was asked to prepare this report to assist the City's Utility Rate Review Committee in considering the City of Medina's water rates.

The following entities were contacted and asked to provide comparative rates:

The City of Akron, The City of Barberton, The City of Canton, The City of Cleveland, Medina County, The City of North Ridgeville, The Rural Lorain County Water Authority (RLCWA), The Village of Seville, The City of Sheffield Lake, The City of Wadsworth

Each of the entities uses a different rate structure. Some of these entities bill water usage in hundreds of cubic feet, some in thousands of gallons, and some in thousands of cubic feet. Some entities have a monthly charge or monthly minimum based on meter size. Additionally, some entities bill monthly, some bill bi-monthly, and some bill quarterly. In order to facilitate apples-to-apples comparisons, monthly rates were calculated for common meter sizes and amounts of usage. Those assumptions as used in the following charts are as follows:


For monthly use of less than 3,700 cubic feet:


Charges used are based on the rate applicable to residential customers with a ¾" meter and residing within the City except as otherwise noted.


For monthly use of 3,700 cubic feet or more:


Charges used are based on the rate applicable to commercial customers with a 3" meter and located within the City except as otherwise noted.


Each of the entities contacted were given copies of the portions of this report relevant to them before this report was released and asked to provide any necessary corrections. Those corrections were incorporated into the final report.




















